





LnF Client Ages




LnF Referral Sources



LnF Clients by Gender




Youth Served by Gender Nationally




LnF Clients by Orientation




Orientation of Youth Served Nationally






LnF Clients by Race/Ethnicity




Atlanta Racial Demographics




LnF Clients by Living Situation




LnF Clients by Foster Care History



LnF Clients' Reason for Homelessness




Top Five Reasons LGBT Youth Are Homeless Nationally




DOCUMENTATION

- 27% do not possess a social security card


LnF Clients by Education Level
